So far it has been a busy year. Our primary team have been able to deliver the Narnia experience just before Christmas, and Prayer Spaces in the few weeks before Easter. Hundreds of children from across the city engaged in both projects exploring the themes of Christianity in the Narnia stories and given time to explore prayer through a dedicated space.

Our Secondary Schools team have been able to start 4 new clubs meaning we now cover 5 of the 7 secondary schools in the area. They personally connect with over 170 young people each week and reached 7,000+ with our Christmas and Easter assemblies. They have also given out over 6,000 biscuits at their clubs.

Groups stage 'live' nativity in new hall garden

MORE than 100 people took part in a live nativity event hosted by Exwick Community Church and led by Exwick Community Church ICE Trust. The event took place on Saturday, December 10, in the new Jubilee Gardens at Exwick Parish Hall. The all-weather shelter with living roof, designed and built by YMCA Exeter staff, local volunteers and YMCA Exeter residents, was transformed into a Christmas stable complete with fairy lights and two donkeys.

The nativity script was written by Sally Naylor from the Exeter ICE primary team. She said: "Our charity has been working in local schools for more than 30 years, bringing Bible stories to life. Events like this are a wonderful opportunity for families not just to hear the Christmas story but to experience it too!"
